Welcome & Intros

Linda welcomed everyone and introduced our guest speaker Courtney Zehr and his family. She thanked Trish Hanna for hosting the meeting in her home.

Old Business

Minutes read. Marilyn Husser asked that the minutes be approved as e-mailed. Minutes were approved.

Treasurer's report. Kathy Cheval reported that our current balance is \$1405.81. That includes a deposit of \$170.17 (proceeds from Craft Faire Food Booth) and an expenditure of \$201.01 (check to the Ninety-Nines Endowment Fund).

New Business

Craft Faire Food Booth. Marilyn Husser gave the final report on the food booth. Our total net at the end of the sale was \$192.80. We had \$160.92 in cash, 18.74 in IOUs and \$13.14 in product. (After meeting update: all remaining products have been spoken for and money will be given to Kathy). What we learned: 1) corn dogs are a favorite among the crafters, 2) one person can handle the sales most of the time, 3) two are necessary from 11:30 am-1 pm, 4) it would be good to have two people for set-up on the first day and two people to dismantle everything at the end of the third day (fourth item was added after the meeting). We agreed to this again next year, if the Craft Faire organizers want us.

Chapter Directory. Debbie is still waiting for profiles from everyone before starting this project.

Updated phone list. Marilyn passed around the first draft of our Chapter's phone list and requested that everyone check their information for accuracy, edit as needed and return it to her.

Book Share. Debbie told us about a book she had found at the Smithsonian Air and Space Museum in Washington DC, Hap Arnold and the Evolution of American
